**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable Paul Mayer**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on May 29, 2018, at 3:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant reported that it had served the Respondent with a copy of its expert report prepared by Mr. Dallas Maynard on May 24, 2018.

[2] The Respondent reported that it has retained Mr. Hal Love to respond to the Maynard Report and to provide an independent opinion on historical land values. On or before June 29, 2018 the Respondent shall advise the Tribunal of the time required by its expert to draft a response report.

[3] The Claimant reported that it had received from the Respondent a revised draft Agreed Statement of Facts on June 30, 2017 and a revised draft Agreed Statement of Issues on August 28, 2017. The Claimant was awaiting receipt of the Maynard Report prior to providing a response to the Respondent. The Claimant shall respond to the revised drafts on or before June 29, 2018.

[4] The Parties shall continue to work towards preparing a Common Book of Documents.

[5] After receiving the Respondent's time estimate, or at the latest on June 29, 2018, the Registry will contact the Parties to assess whether or not a CMC is required.
