**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable William Grist**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on March 21, 2018, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties expressed interest in a tripartite negotiation of the Claim with the Government of Alberta. The Respondent was hopeful that they would have a start by the end of

April and an update on potential funding in May. The Claimant affirmed its interest in keeping open the option of returning to the Tribunal.

[2] The Tribunal put forward the following 2 prospects to the Parties regarding a possible stay of proceedings:

- i. Formalize the stay by filing an Application for a stay of proceedings; or,
- ii. Allow for a period of time to see if the proposed discussions will amount to a negotiation, but not have the Claim enter an official stay of proceedings.

[3] The Parties agreed to take no further steps in the proceedings until after May 2018 to assess the progress made towards negotiation. After that time period, the Parties will determine what procedure they would like to incorporate as far as the Claim is concerned.

[4] The Parties shall file with their briefs for the next CMC a joint status report, or separate status reports, on the progress made in respect of advancing the process of tripartite negotiation between them and the Government of Alberta on the issues raised in this Claim. The status report or reports do not need to include details of without prejudice communications, but should include high level updates on the process being followed and estimated timelines.

[5] The Parties shall be in contact with the Registry to schedule the next CMC to be held by teleconference on a date of mutual convenience in the month of June or July 2018.
