THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:

[1] The Parties are relieved from the requirement to file the Terms of Reference of the joint expert in paragraph 2 of the Endorsement and Order of the Tribunal dated July 25, 2018;

[2] The Parties shall inform the Tribunal in writing of any expert reports, separate or joint, commissioned or obtained during the period of the stay, including the subject matter of the report;

[3] The Parties shall inform the Tribunal of the dates for delivery of any expert reports;

[4] The Parties shall contact the Registry to schedule the next CMC which is to occur as soon after January 2, 2019 as is convenient for the Parties; and,

[5] The stay of proceedings granted in the Endorsement and Order of the Tribunal dated July 25, 2018 is extended from December 1, 2018 to January 2, 2019.
