ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on June 6, 2017, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent was to serve and file its reply expert surveyor report on or before July 31, 2017, but by follow up letter dated July 31, 2017, the Respondent advised the Tribunal that the Parties consented to an extension to do so on or before **August 18, 2017**.

[2] By separate follow up letter dated July 31, 2017, the Respondent advised the Tribunal that the Parties have consented to extend the deadline to address objections (if any) to new documents exchanged between the Parties in mid-July from August 4, 2017, to on or before **August 25, 2017**.

[3] As part of the validity stage of the Claim, a witness hearing (one witness from the Claimant First Nation and the Parties' expert witnesses) and site visit to Rebecca Spit will be held on **December 5, 2017** for a duration of two or three days at a location (likely on Quadra Island) to be confirmed. The Claimant shall advise the Registry of the location of this evidence hearing. Oral submissions may be held in April or May 2018.

[4] The Respondent will discuss some evidentiary source matters (such as news articles) with the Claimant and attempt to sort out any issues prior to the next CMC. This matter will be revisited at the next CMC.

[5] The next CMC has now been scheduled for **August 24, 2017**, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa). Validity oral submissions hearing dates may be confirmed at this time.
