ENDORSEMENT AND ORDER

Honourable William Grist

FURTHER to a Case Management Conference (CMC) held by teleconference on May 16, 2019, at 3:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa);

THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:

[1] A stay of proceedings is granted for six months, namely until November 15, 2019, to allow the Parties to continue in a trilateral negotiation process involving Alberta that includes the exchange or transfer of land;

[2] The Parties shall file a joint status report apprising the Tribunal of the negotiation process to date and going forward. The joint status report need not comply with Practice Direction #15 given the nature of the negotiations and their advanced stage; and,

[3] The next CMC shall be held prior to November 15, 2019. If the Parties wish to extend the stay of proceedings past November 15, 2019, they shall file a joint status report updating the Tribunal on past and future negotiations with as much information as possible. Again, Practice Direction #15 need not be complied with.
