ENDORSEMENT AND ORDER

Honourable William Grist

FURTHER to a Case Management Conference (CMC) held by teleconference on April 18, 2019, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa):

[1] The Parties requested an extension of the stay of proceedings in order to review and take account of a jointly commissioned expert report they anticipate will be finalized this summer. They provided little information regarding the status of negotiations and would not commit to formalizing an agreement regarding the validity of the Claim.

THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:

[2] The stay of proceedings is extended until the next CMC, conditional upon receiving a letter from both Parties when the expert report is finalized;

[3] The Parties are to comply with Practice Direction #15 for the next CMC, including *inter alia* advising the Tribunal of the following in their CMC Briefs:

- a. a summary to date of negotiations;
- b. an upcoming schedule of negotiations;
- c. each Party's positions on validity, including a statement of points of agreement;
- d. a description of outstanding contentious issues; and,
- e. each Party's positions on mediation.

[4] The next CMC shall be scheduled as soon as it is convenient after September 1, 2019.
