A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on August 24, 2017, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant shall serve and file its supplementary expert report on or before **October 13, 2017**.

[2] The oral history evidence hearing for one Elder and a site visit will take place on **December 5, 2017**, at the Band Office of Campbell River First Nation (Wei Wai Kum First Nation) in Campbell River, British Columbia.

[3] The Respondent indicated that it is undertaking what it considers to be crucial further research in respect of the Claim which may take 4 to 6 months to complete as a new tender contract for its expert must be secured before the research can commence. The Claimant might need to conduct additional research in turn. The Parties are targeting to finalize the Common Book of Documents in March of 2018.

[4] The expert evidence hearing and oral submissions hearing will be held from **April 24 to April 27, 2018**, and may also be held at the same location as the oral history evidence hearing. It is to be noted that unless there are exceptional circumstances requiring an extended adjournment following the expert evidence hearing, these two hearings are to be held during the same week.

[5] The Registry shall contact the Parties to schedule a time for a Pre-Hearing Conference to be held sometime prior to the beginning of the oral history evidence hearing and site visit.
