**ENDORSEMENT**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on January 8, 2016, at 3:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant's initially-proposed oral history witness passed away before the Oral History Hearing could be held, resulting in that Hearing date being adjourned to February 23, 2016 while the Claimant searched for replacement witnesses. The Claimant reported that three

new potential witnesses had been identified but could not be interviewed until January 14, 2016. The Claimant will identify the names of the proposed witnesses to the Respondent and will provide the Respondent with Will-Says of the new witness' anticipated oral history evidence on or before **January 22, 2016**.

[2] The Claimant indicated that translation may be required for the new oral history witnesses, and that if so, the Claimant will identify the proposed interpreter and the language for interpretation to the Respondent on or before **January 22, 2016**. The Claimant undertook to arrange for and provide the interpreter at the Oral History Hearing if the proposed interpreter is acceptable to the Respondent.

[3] Provided the Will-Says are sufficient and delivered on time to the Respondent, and provided the proposed interpreter is acceptable to the Respondent, the Oral History Hearing will be held in the Claimant's community, commencing at 10:00 A.M., on February 23, 2016.
