**ENDORSEMENT**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on April 5, 2018, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties and the Tribunal discussed the nature and potential value of the Claim.

[2] The Respondent shall serve and file its expert report on or before **June 29, 2018**, and the Claimant shall serve and file its reply expert report on or before **September 14, 2018**.

[3] Once both expert reports are filed, the Parties will consider if a meeting between the experts would be beneficial. If the Parties' experts meet and resolve some issues, they will provide a short, combined report identifying points on which they agree and disagree.

[4] The Parties agreed that the hearing will include testimony of expert and lay witnesses, as well as oral submissions, and that they will file written submissions after the hearing.

[5] The Parties agreed to address, in a letter to follow, their availability for a five day hearing of expert evidence and oral submissions commencing November 19, 2018, and the schedule for written submissions.

[6] A further oral submissions hearing may be scheduled at the request of the Tribunal after receipt of the Parties' written submissions.

[7] The Parties will notify the Registry of their availability for a Pre-Hearing Conference to be held as soon as possible after November 1, 2018.

[8] The Tribunal raised, and Counsel for each Party acknowledged, the modest potential value of the Claim. The Tribunal encouraged the Parties to make best efforts to resolve the Claim.
