ENDORSEMENT

Honourable W.L. Whalen

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on July 4, 2016 at 9:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties reported that they were working cooperatively on the preparation of a Common Book of Documents, which is in the late stages of completion. The Tribunal agrees that it is better that one jointly prepared Common Book of Documents is preferable to each party

preparing its own Book of Documents and encourages the Parties to organize one Common Book of Documents, albeit divided into however many volumes they agree to be appropriate. The filing of the Common Book of Documents will otherwise be done in accordance with Practice Direction # 8. The Parties are to complete the Common Book of Documents on or before **September 30, 2016**.

[2] The Parties reported that they were working cooperatively on an Agreed Statement of Facts, which the Claimant has been drafting as the Common Book of Documents is being developed. The Claimant is to deliver a draft Agreed Statement of Facts to the Respondent on or before **October 14, 2016**.

[3] The Parties agree that the testimony of their respective experts will form the evidence at the validity hearing. The experts will deal with documents filed (Common Book of Documents) as part of their opinions and testimony. If there is a finding of validity, questions of historical value and present value will be dealt with in the Compensation Phase of the process in one or two sub-phases as may be appropriate.

[4] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **October 24, 2016** at 9:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa). Justice B. MacDougall will be presiding and managing this Claim henceforth.
