A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on June 28, 2018, at 12:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties are now engaged in gathering evidence to mediate the issue of compensation.

[2] The Parties have agreed to work cooperatively to draft terms of reference for each potential area of loss. The Respondent shall provide the Claimant with the first draft of the Terms of Reference on or before **July 30, 2018**. The Claimant will have 30 days from the time it receives the draft Terms of Reference to provide comments to the Respondent.

[3] The Parties will determine if they will be engaging joint experts or separate experts within 30 to 60 days, at the latest a decision will be made on or by August 27, 2018.

[4] On or before **August 15, 2018** the Claimant will notify the Respondent on if and who will be the elders that will assist the experts with the potential loss of use study. The Parties are giving thought on ways of preserving the elder evidence for future use.

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **October 17, 2018**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
