ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on July 5, 2018, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant reported that it had been delayed in delivering its expert’s response to the Respondent’s expert report because the expert had been working in the field to take best advantage of non-winter time. The Claimant indicated that it would deliver its expert’s response

on or before July 13, 2018. The Parties will then consider arranging a meeting of their experts with a view to attempting to resolve differences.

[2] The Claimant undertook to provide a list of prospective economists to the Respondent for consideration. If the present experts meet and can reconcile sufficient areas of difference, the Parties are open to considering the retainer of one expert to report according to terms of reference jointly drawn.

[3] Progress on the experts and whether expert economists will be necessary will be considered at the next CMC.

[4] The Parties are urged to commence developing a list of documents for a Common Book of Documents as well as commencing the draft of an Agreed Statement of Issues and Agreed Statement of Facts. This may expedite progress toward a hearing once expert reports are complete.

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **September 25, 2018**, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
