ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on January 15, 2018, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties reported that they are working collaboratively on the preparation of an Agreed Statement of Facts, Agreed Statement of Issues and Common Book of Documents, which cannot be completed until all of the experts' reports and testimony have been received.

[2] The Claimant indicated that it now expects its expert's loss of use report to be completed on or before **February 28, 2018**.

[3] The Respondent's expert, Mr. Hal Love, will be asked to prepare an expert report in response to the third phase of the Claimant's expert's report, and to that end Mr. Love's contract of engagement is in process of being amended. In the federal government process this requires time. The Respondent is hopeful that Mr. Love will complete this report on or before **April 30, 2018**.

[4] The Claimant confirmed that it will not be seeking a historical tracing report.

[5] The Parties expect that there will be a separate hearing to receive the experts' testimony. The place, time and length of such a hearing will be considered at the next CMC, which will also consider progress on the completion of Mr. Love's final expert report and the question of bifurcation.

[6] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **April 9, 2018**, at 12:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
