ENDORSEMENT

Honourable Harry Slade, Chairperson

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on June 20, 2018, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties shall file with the Tribunal a joint statement acknowledging the following on or before **July 18, 2018:**

- a) that the Respondent has admitted to the validity of the Claim, and on which basis; and,
- b) that should compensation negotiations fail, the Tribunal will not be asked to hear evidence or make any determinations regarding validity, and will only adjudicate issues of compensation.

[2] The Respondent's expert report by Mr. Hal Love is to be provided to the Claimant by the end of October. When such delivery is made, the Respondent shall notify the Tribunal for the record.

[3] The following items will be discussed at the next CMC:

- a) the completion and delivery to the Claimant of the Respondent's expert report prepared by Mr. Hal Love;
- b) whether further expert reports are needed and if so, have they been commissioned and what are the expected completion and delivery dates;
- c) progress towards a settlement; and,
- d) if the Parties wish to stay proceedings while in negotiations they may request same without formal application. If a stay is granted, the Tribunal will impose a time limit, reporting requirements and may impose other conditions including mediation.

[4] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **October 10, 2018**, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
