**ENDORSEMENT**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on February 27, 2018, at 3:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant shall review the Respondent’s list of documents omitted from the Common Book of Documents in order to determine whether it requires any of them to be included in the Common Book of Documents. The Claimant shall advise the Respondent of the outcome on or

before **March 15, 2018**, so it can take necessary steps to finalize the Common Book of Documents.

[2] The oral submissions hearing will no longer be held with the expert evidence hearing. The expert evidence hearing shall take place from **April 24 to 27, 2018**, at the Cape Mudge Band Office on Quadra Island, British Columbia. The Claimant's expert will testify first and will speak to and be cross-examined on both of his reports. The Respondent's expert testimony will then follow and the totality of his evidence will be taken. Any further reply to the testimony will only be as directed by the Tribunal.

[3] The Parties shall provide the Registry with available dates for the oral submissions hearing to be held after the first week of October 2018 and shall file their written submissions with the Tribunal according to the following timelines:

- a. the Claimant shall file and serve its written submissions on or before **June 29, 2018**;
- b. the Respondent shall serve and file its written submission on or before **July 31, 2018**; and,
- c. the Claimant shall serve and file its reply written submissions, if any, on or before **August 24, 2018**.

[4] The Registry shall contact the Parties to schedule a time for a Pre-Hearing Conference to be held sometime prior to the beginning of the expert evidence hearing.
