ENDORSEMENT AND ORDER

FURTHER to a Case Management Conference (CMC) held by teleconference on December 5, 2018, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa):

[1] On November 26, 2018, the Parties filed a Joint Status Report to extend the stay of proceedings in order to negotiate a settlement on compensation. The Parties filed on August 28, 2018, a Tribunal Work Plan contemplating a one year negotiation.

[2] On August 17, 2018, the Claimant retained an expert to provide an appraisal report to inform negotiations by providing current unimproved market values and loss of use. The Claimant's report should be completed by early February 2019. The Respondent is in the process of retaining its own expert for an appraisal report. The Respondent anticipates receipt of its expert appraisal report by March 2019. The expert reports shall be in a format that will be useable by the Tribunal should it become necessary.

[3] Once the expert reports are received and reviewed by each Party, the Parties shall schedule further negotiations.

THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:

[4] A stay of proceedings is granted for an additional six months, namely until June 5, 2019;

[5] The Parties are to report back to the Tribunal by filing a Joint Status Report before the end of June 2019; and,

[6] The next CMC will be held by teleconference as soon as the Parties' schedules will allow after July 1, 2019.
