ENDORSEMENT AND ORDER

Honourable Paul Mayer

FURTHER to a Case Management Conference (CMC) held by teleconference on February 11, 2019, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa):

[1] The Parties anticipate being able to come to an agreement with respect to the Terms of Reference for the expert report of Hal Love on or before **March 13, 2019**. The Parties shall

advise the Tribunal by joint brief once they have reached an agreement on the Terms of Reference.

[2] Once the Parties have come to an agreement on the Terms of Reference for Mr. Love, the Respondent will be able to seek internal approval of a contract for Mr. Love. The Respondent estimates that it can take up to four months to enter into a contract with Mr. Love. The Respondent shall advise the Tribunal once it is aware of the time frame that will be required to finalize the contract.

THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:

[3] The stay of proceedings is extended until August 12, 2019; and,

[4] Either Party may request a CMC from the Tribunal at any time if it requires the assistance of the Tribunal to resolve an issue.
