

evidentiary gaps in the report as a result of unavailable documents, the Claimant did not propose pursuing further investigation.

[2] The Respondent reported that its genealogical experts had submitted an initial draft report, as had its survey/boundary expert. Those reports are in the late stages of finalization. The Respondent has no firm date of completion of its expert reports although it hopes they will be done by the end of December 2018 or early January 2019. The Respondent is working with its experts to narrow the issues from its perspective in order to work further with the Claimant in that direction and in a spirit of reconciliation.

[3] The Parties expressed interest in Tribunal assisted mediation and the Respondent confirmed that it had been instructed to explore a mediated resolution. The Parties were reminded of the Tribunal's new Practice Directions # 14 and # 15. Mediation will be discussed at the next CMC.

[4] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **March 4, 2019**, at 12:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
