A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on May 8, 2017, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent reported that it had produced all the documents it was able to obtain for purposes of clarification, except for one. It is still waiting for an archival response and will inform the Claimant accordingly and produce a copy of the document if it is available. This and

the other documents produced will be placed in a Supplementary Common Book of Documents that will not be difficult to finalize.

[2] The Claimant indicated that it had decided not to proceed with its expert report.

[3] The Parties are working cooperatively on an Agreed Statement of Facts, which is in an advanced state of preparation. They hope a final version may be completed by the next CMC.

[4] The Claimant indicated that finalization of an Agreed Statement of Issues was not possible until the Agreed Statement of Facts had been completed. The Claimant undertook to provide a draft Agreed Statement of Issues at that time.

[5] Prior to the next CMC, the Parties shall propose joint dates and location for a hearing of the Respondent's expert to the Registry.

[6] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **July 6, 2017**, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
