ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on January 15, 2018, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties reported that they have worked collaboratively on the preparation of a Common Book of Documents, Agreed Statement of Facts and Agreed Statement of Issues, which cannot be completed until witness testimony has been received.

[2] Expert reports are now complete. The Respondent continues to attempt to identify a Manitoba Hydro witness with Manitoba Hydro's cooperation. None has been identified yet, so the Respondent may have to proceed by subpoena if it thinks it necessary.

[3] The testimony of the experts and possibly a Manitoba Hydro witness will be received at a hearing commencing on May 22, 2018 at 10:00 A.M. and continuing through May 24, 2018 at a location to be confirmed with the Registry as soon as possible by counsel for the Parties and no later than **February 28, 2018**.

[4] If the Respondent seeks bifurcation of the validity and compensation phases of the Claim, it will file the appropriate Application with the Tribunal on or before **March 15, 2017**.

[5] The next CMC will consider the Parties' readiness for the expert evidence hearing and the question of bifurcation, including the setting of a date to hear an Application.

[6] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **April 3, 2018**, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
