[1] The Parties have agreed to jointly hire a land valuation expert and will have finalized the contracting process on or before June 11, 2018. Once the land valuation expert is contracted, the Parties will advise the Tribunal in writing of the required time for the expert to complete their report.

[2] The Respondent shall provide the Claimant with commentary and revisions to the draft Agreed Statement of Facts on or before **April 23, 2018**. The Parties shall file the final Agreed Statement of Facts with the Tribunal on or before **May 8, 2018**.
