ENDORSEMENT AND ORDER

Honourable William Grist

FURTHER to a Case Management Conference (CMC) held by teleconference on December 17, 2018, at 4:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa):

[1] The Parties reported that negotiations are underway regarding compensation for the Claim. The Parties met to discuss the Claim on April 12, 2018, September 18, 2018, and December 6, 2018. The Claimant has provided a position letter to the Respondent and the Respondent is considering it. The Claimant also has a draft expert appraisal report that is in the

final stages of preparation, and the Respondent has arranged its affairs such that once it receives the report it can respond efficiently. Three more meetings are scheduled to be held on January 23, 2019, February 28, 2019, and March 26, 2019.

[2] The Parties expressed confidence in the progress of negotiations.

[3] The Tribunal is satisfied that a further stay of proceedings is appropriate.

THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:

[4] The stay of proceedings is extended until **May 17, 2019**.

[5] The next CMC will be held as soon as may be practically arranged after May 17, 2019. The Parties will notify the Registry of their preferred date and time.
