ENDORSEMENT

A Pre-Hearing Conference was held by teleconference on May 24, 2018, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties reported that they have agreed to jointly hire a land valuation expert and will have finalized the contracting process on or before June 11, 2018. Once the land valuation expert is contracted, the Parties will advise the Tribunal in writing of the required time for the expert to complete their report.

[2] The oral history evidence hearing will commence with a pipe ceremony at 10:00 A.M., Central Time (Saskatchewan) on June 19, 2018.

[3] The Claimant informed the Tribunal that its only witness, Elder James O'Watch, is dealing with a critical health condition and is waiting to receive a letter from his doctor the week of May 28, 2018. The Claimant believes that this letter will clear up to some extent the status of Elder O'Watch's health, and undertook to advise the Tribunal and the Respondent of the outcome. The Claimant will then also advise the Tribunal and the Respondent whether a member of the community will be introducing Elder O'Watch.

[4] On or before **May 31, 2018**, the Claimant shall advise the Tribunal and the Respondent in writing if the June 19, 2018 oral history evidence hearing can proceed as planned or if it needs to be postponed.
