A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on May 22, 2018, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant reported that it does not intend to bring forward oral history evidence further to its letter to the Tribunal dated May 16, 2018.

[2] The Tribunal encouraged the Parties to have their experts meet to see if they can agree on issues.

[3] The Parties shall report to the Tribunal in writing on or before **June 5, 2018** on the following matters:

- a. Whether or not it is necessary for the experts to be examined on their reports at a hearing, and, if so, if there is to be an expert evidence hearing, whether the oral submissions hearing can proceed directly afterwards;
- b. Possible hearing date(s) for an expert evidence hearing, if needed, and the oral submissions hearing and whether Wanuskewin Heritage Park, Saskatoon would be acceptable as a venue;
- c. The timelines for the exchange of the following written submissions:
 - i. The filing of the Claimant's Memorandum of Fact and Law with the Tribunal;
 - ii. The filing of the Respondent's Memorandum of Fact and Law with the Tribunal; and,
 - iii. The filing of the Claimant's Reply, if any, which shall be filed with the Tribunal at least 5 days in advance of the commencement of the oral submissions hearing.
