A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on September 5, 2018, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent indicated that Canada continues to have a mandate to negotiate this Claim based on Canada's original offer to negotiate. The Respondent will confirm whether the mandate covers both the Ontario and Manitoba Garden Islands.

[2] The Tribunal indicated that it wishes to see this file resolved as quickly and effectively as possible. In order to be able to issue a stay of proceedings, the Tribunal would require additional information.

[3] Prior to the next CMC, the Parties shall discuss what expert reports they believe will be necessary, whether the reports will be joint or separate, the estimated time lines necessary to obtain the expert reports, and whether the expert reports can be used in a Tribunal hearing should negotiations fail. The Parties shall file this information in a brief with the Tribunal.

[4] Prior to the next CMC, the Parties shall discuss and create a work plan for negotiations, including matters such as the frequency and dates of meetings. The Parties shall include this information in their brief to be filed with the Tribunal.

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **October 15, 2018**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
