A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on October 31, 2017, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties shall discuss dates and a possible venue for a four day expert evidence hearing to be held in the first three weeks of June 2018 and advise the Tribunal on or before **November 3, 2017**.

[2] The hearing will be for the examination of experts on the volume of timber removed from the reserve, and, if possible, it will also be on the present day value of compensation.

[3] On or before the next CMC, the Claimants will advise on the date on which they will be able to provide to the Respondent expert reports on the following issues:

- i. The present day value of compensation; and
- ii. Historical information concerning the penalty provisions under the *Indian Act*, RSC 1886, c 43.

[4] The Claimants expect to be able to respond to the Respondent regarding the draft Agreed Statement of Issues on or before **November 14, 2017**.

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **December 4, 2017**, at 12:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
