ENDORSEMENT

Honourable Paul Mayer

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on November 21, 2018, at 12:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] Following receipt of the Joint Expert Historical Appraisal Report (Joint Appraisal Report), the Tribunal encourages the Parties to consider Tribunal-assisted mediation or other alternative forms of resolution. The Parties are currently exploring the possibility of alternative dispute resolutions.

[2] The Parties have presented and the Tribunal has accepted the following Joint Plan of Proceeding:

- The Parties expect to receive the draft Joint Appraisal Report from their joint expert on or before **January 20, 2019**;
- The Parties shall review the draft Joint Appraisal Report and discuss any issues for the joint expert's consideration, 30 days from receipt of the draft Report;
- The Parties shall convene a CMC with the Tribunal to get direction on any outstanding issues in the draft Joint Appraisal Report, if necessary, 45 days from receipt of the draft Report. The Parties shall file the final Joint Appraisal Report with the Tribunal 60 days from receipt of the draft Report;
- The Claimant shall serve and file with the Tribunal its written submissions 60 days from the filing of the Joint Appraisal Report;
- The Respondent shall serve and file with the Tribunal its written submissions 60 days from receiving the Claimant's written submissions; and,
- The Claimant shall serve and file with the Tribunal its reply submissions (if necessary) 15 days from receiving the Respondent's written submissions.

[3] Five days will be set aside for a validity hearing in Regina, Saskatchewan, ideally during September 2019. Specific dates for this hearing will be discussed at the next CMC.

[4] The next CMC will be held on **February 14, 2019**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
