

AND FURTHER to a Direction dated October 5, 2018, the Tribunal invited the Respondent to respond to the Claimant's Submissions on the appropriate page limit for the Memorandum of Fact and Law filed with the Tribunal on October 3, 2018;

AND CONSIDERING THAT:

- a. the Tribunal has reviewed the Claimant's submissions suggesting a page limit of seventy (70) pages for its Memorandum of Fact and Law, and arguing that this Specific Claim was complex; and,
- b. the Tribunal has also reviewed the Respondent's submissions, suggesting a page limit of sixty (60) pages for each Party's Memorandum of Fact and Law, and arguing that this would be a reasonable limit that would encourage the Parties to focus their written arguments on the key issues.

AND PURSUANT to Rule 3 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Rules of Practice and Procedure* SOR/2001-119;

THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:

[1] The Memoranda of Fact and Law for each Party shall be no longer than seventy (70) pages double spaced.
