[1] The Respondent indicated that within the week, it hopes to file its index to a second collection of documents, being some or all of the documents cited by Dr. Dorothy Kennedy in her expert report.

[2] The Claimant's Memorandum of Fact and Law is to be filed on or before **November 9, 2018**, pursuant to the Direction of the Tribunal dated October 25, 2018. However, if the Respondent has not filed its index to the second collection of documents, on or before **November 6, 2018**, then the Claimant's Memorandum of Fact and Law shall be filed three (3) business days after delivery of the Respondent's second collection of documents.

[3] The Claimant and the Respondent will both exchange and file with the Tribunal indexed and tabbed Books of Documents of Secondary Sources on or before **January 18, 2019**.

[4] The Claimant shall amend paragraph 107(o) of its Further Amended Declaration of Claim to clarify it by removing the allegation of a breach of fiduciary duty in failing to secure a grazing commonage.
