ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on May 10, 2017, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties reported that they had agreed to and filed an Agreed Protocol on Lay Witness Evidence with the Tribunal on April 13, 2017. The Claimants indicated that they will deliver Will-Say Statements for their 7 proposed witnesses on or before **May 29, 2017**. The Respondent confirmed that it will not present any lay witnesses.

[2] The Respondent produced its expert's report on April 26, 2017 and underlying supporting materials on May 8, 2017. The Claimants reported that they do not intend to engage a responding expert but may produce further documents as a response. Such documents are to be produced on or before **May 31, 2017**.

[3] Upon the consent of the Parties, the schedule for Stage 1 of the Compensation Phase as directed in the Appendix to the Endorsement of September 7, 2016 is amended as follows:

- a. A Common Book of Documents intended to be used with witnesses during the evidentiary hearing shall be filed with the Tribunal on or before **June 12, 2017**;
- b. The Agreed Statement of Facts shall be filed with the Tribunal on or before **September 1, 2017**; and,
- c. The Common Book of Documents shall be filed with the Tribunal on or before **November 10, 2017**.

[4] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **September 26, 2017**, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa), to review readiness for the Stage 1 hearing of submissions in the Compensation Phase.
