**ENDORSEMENT**

[1] A Case Management Conference was held in Saskatoon on Friday April 20, 2012.  
Counsel agreed to the proposed procedural timeline for this proceeding.

[2] The following procedural timeline is approved by the Tribunal:

**Agreed Statement of Facts**

- The Crown will draft a Statement of Facts and forward it to the Claimant for comments by July 15, 2012.
- The Claimant will provide its comments to the Crown by August 31, 2012.
- The parties will file with the Tribunal a copy of the Agreed Statement of Facts.
- The parties will inform the Tribunal of any disagreement in this regard, if any.

**Agreed Statement of Issues**

- The Claimant shall draft a Statement of Issues and forward it to the Crown for comments by May 15, 2012.
- The Crown will provide its comments to the Claimant by July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012.
- The parties will file with the Tribunal a copy of the Agreed Statement of Issues.
- The parties will inform the Tribunal of any disagreement in this regard, if any.

**Common Book of Documents**

- The Claimant will endeavor to produce a documentary record by August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2012;
- The Crown will notify the Tribunal and the Claimant whether it has concerns with the Claimant's proposed documentary record by September 30, 2012, with the exception of documents that may be generated later, and notably those that may be filed with the expert reports.
- The Crown will inform the Claimant within the next two weeks (by May 5, 2012) of its position regarding the disclosure of any Orders-in-Council in the Crown's possession providing the authority for any expenditure from the Claimant's Capital and Interest/Revenue Accounts.

**Next Case Management Conference**

- Next CMC to be scheduled during the first week of October 2012. Parties agreed to proceed by Video Conference. The Registry will communicate with the parties to schedule the CMC. The issue of bifurcation shall be reviewed with the parties during this CMC.
